Aperturation, families, and specific binomials are printed above the micrographs. The second pollen poster is a compilation of 137 B&W SEM micrographs of 89 different pollen taxa in the plant family Fabaceae, common in the Southeastern United States. The specific binomials and scale in micrometers are printed above each micrograph. It is a handy reference for those palynologists examining pollen samples from various regions of North America, especially samples that contain insect-pollinated taxa, particularly species of clover.
